



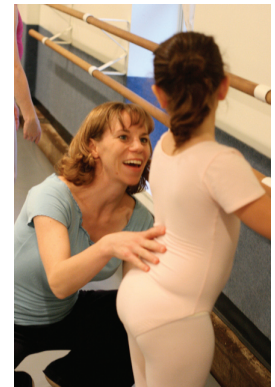

# Policy Statement

★ Students register for 33 classes during the 10 month school year. The Year End Show rehearsals count as 1 class. Please count the 33 classes on the calendar.

★ If you chose the Payment Plan, payments are due on the first (1st) of each of the 10 school months. A 4% late charge will be added to the unpaid balance for payment made after the 1st of the month. All accounts in arrears of 2 months or more will be subject to 19% interest charges, and students will not be allowed to attend class until the balance is paid. All bills that are sent to collection will have an added 33% to pay for collection charges.

★ Credit Card Payment is now offered. See the office on how to pay by credit card.

★ Checks returned from our bank as uncollectible will be charged as an additional \$30.00 fee. Patrons must pay by money order, credit card or cash from thereon once a check has been returned.

★ Please note: if a student wishes to withdraw from the program notice must be given in writing. Students/parents are responsible for tuition incurred until the end of payment cycle in which we receive the written notice of withdrawal. Re-registering students in the same school year must pay the \$35 registration fee in order to start classes again.

★ In case of the cancellation of classes due to bad weather, the Dance Design School will make every effort to provide the 33 classes upon which the tuition schedule is based. The Dance Design School however, is not obliged to make up all or part of classes canceled due to bad weather. Students are encouraged to make up in comparable or lower level classes whenever possible. Check the web site, [dancedesignschool.com](http://dancedesignschool.com) or call the studio 534-9671 if in doubt. There will be no individual make up classes after May 1st. We have never missed providing 33 classes.

Please contact Ms. Aggie with any questions concerning the class schedule. Please find the notes that pertain to you and your dancer.

★ **Young Dancer Classes:** Ballet classes for ages 2 to 7 (Parent & ME!, Creative Movement, KinderDance, Pre-Primary and Primary) are designed to be taken once a week. Ballet classes for ages 8 to 9 (Grade 1 and 2) are designed to be taken twice a week. Ballet Classes for ages 10 to 12 (Grade 3, 4 and 5) are designed to be taken twice a week with the addition of Non Syllabus classes added in where desired. These classes, especially our classes for 2 to 7 year olds are sometimes offered more times a week; if your child would like to attend more then the usual amount and you do not feel it will be too much of a commitment, you may sign up for the additional classes. (Feel free to call and discuss this option with Aggie if you have questions.)

★ **Non-Syllabus Classes:** The work taught will be of a corresponding Royal Academy of Dance (R.A.D.) class level. NO RAD syllabus work will be taught in a Non-Syllabus class. There will be no exam offered in these classes. Please Note: If you are in RAD Grade 3, 4, or 5 and want to take a Non-Syllabus class, you must first take 2 RAD classes per week. Those wishing to take an upper level (Intermediate or Advanced) Non-Syllabus class must first take 1 RAD class.

★ **Pointe Classes:** Due to the rigourous demands of pointe classes; Beginner Pointe requires 2 R.A.D. classes a week in addition to pointe (there is a \$29 per month fee in order to take this 30 minute class). Intermediate Pointe requires 3 ballet classes per week in addition to pointe (this class is counted as a full class when paying). Advanced 1 Pointe requires 4 ballet classes per week in addition to pointe. Advanced 2 Pointe requires 5 ballet classes per week in addition to pointe. Variation Pointe requires 5 ballet classes plus permission from the director. These rules are for the dancer's safety. Pointe work can be dangerous if the dancer is not strong enough. As with any physical activity injury is a possibility, but the required ballet classes help to minimize the possibility of injury. Pointe placement is not up to the child, but is at the sole discretion of the teacher. Please Note: The teacher will tell your child when she is ready to start pointe work. Please ask the teacher if you are confused as to why your child may have been held back a level. We are always happy to explain and help.

★ Any parent whose child has completed a Grade 5 R.A.D. level must schedule a time to come into the studio and schedule classes (It takes 45 to 90 minutes). Please Note: Grade 5 and above students will not be able to attend class during 2010-2011 until a meeting has been held with the student, parent and teacher (Parent and Student MUST both attend). Please call the studio to set up an appointment. Meetings will be held from August 23 to September 3; from 10:00am-12:00pm and 2:00pm-4:00pm, by appointment. Some July and early August appointments will be offered, please call to schedule your time.

★ **Jazz, Tap and Modern:** Classes are consolidated in order to keep the energy level needed in the class high. This year we will be joining 2 levels for each jazz, tap and modern class. All our teachers will be sure, as usual, that each child feels special and part of the group.

★ **Class Helpers:** Any dancer who takes a ballet level Grade 3 or above, 2 or more times per week, is eligible to assist in a lower level dance class. Class helper spots fill up quickly and are on a first come first serve basis. There is no fee to be a class helper and the rewards are wonderful for dancers and helpers alike! Call the Office for details and to sign up for a class.

★ **Year End Show Costumes:** D.D.S. policy is to rent costumes to dancers (except creative movement and kindergarten dance) for our year end show in June. This saves parents the expense of buying a costume that can range in price from \$65. to

\$120.! The studio rental fee is \$22 per costume. This money is pooled together and used to purchase new costumes for a few classes and embellishments for currently owned costumes. Costumes are fitted during class and transported to the theatre by a large truck. The costumes are cleaned after the shows by volunteer parents.

★ **Studio's:** We will have 3 studio's this year. They are listed on the schedule Studio A, B and C. Studio A and B will be located at the 291 Main Street location. Studio C will be located at 297 A Main Street, 2 doors down from the main studio. Children who will be walking between studios will not have to cross any streets. There is a large sidewalk and it is less than a 2 minute walk. Dancers Grade 2 and lower will be accompanied by the teacher. Classes may change rooms due to class size or teacher convenience.

★ **Registration:** On the Class Schedule you will notice that we have numbered the classes which we feel will most benefit each student. They are numbered by hand in the priority in which they should be taken.

For Example: 1 class a week. Take class hand numbered 1.

2 classes a week. Take classes hand numbered 1 and 2.

And so on.

Please call if your child wants something different from what we have suggested (for example, modern instead of jazz or ballet instead of tap).

★ If your child has expressed interest in 'Doing dance professionally' (dance company, musical theatre, teach any form of dance, music videos, TV, etc...) or wishes to attend professional summer programs (The Rock, SAB, Carlisle, NYSSSA, Boston) or wishes to 'double up' classes (take two levels in one school year) or wants to eventually attend a college dance program, Please call the studio ASAP. Long term dancing goals must be started young! We will be glad to help guide you as to what needs to be done to help achieve your child's goal. We do not highlight classes to reflect a "professional track".

★ **HVDT:** Tentative dates for the "Nutcracker Short & Sweet" performance will be Sat. Dec. 11 and Sun Dec. 12. Grade 2 to Grade 5 (Grade 1 with Aggie's permission) Sign Ups for the Hudson Valley Dance Theatre are Saturday September 25 from 3:00-4:00. Requirements: 2 ballet classes per week. There will be a volunteer meeting for the parents at 3:45.

Grade 5 and up Auditions will be Wednesday Sept 1 from 5:00-7:00. Parent volunteer meeting from 7:00-7:15. Requirements: 5 ballet classes per week for corps; 5 ballet classes per week and have taken 3 full weeks of any summer dance program in 2010 (minimum of 30 classes) for corps and minor lead roles; 7 ballet classes per week and have taken 3 full weeks of any summer program for corps and major solos.

FREE classes will be held from Monday August 16 thru Tuesday August 31 from 5:00-7:00 for all students who wish to audition for the company. Classes are free as long as you are auditioning for the Senior Company.

Company Dues are \$195 for Junior Company and \$220 for Senior Company. If a parent volunteers for a designated volunteer position company dues are \$100 less per child.

Please call if you have any questions about the requirements to join the Hudson Valley Dance Theatre or what the time commitment may be for you and your child.

★ **MOST IMPORTANT:** Most classes will fill up VERY quickly! In order to save a spot in the class of your choice you must be one of the first people to send back a registration form.
