Each Act is approximately 20 minutes.

The plan is to hold our show outdoors on May 22 and 23 at 4pm.

We would have 2 shows over the course of 1 weekend, one Saturday and 1 Sunday. Dress rehearsals will happen on the morning before the show.

If we cannot have an outdoor show, we will film the show inside studio A, without an audience. A DVD will be given to each dancer.

If we have an outdoor show, we will need lots of help. Please plan to help in some way if we have an outdoor show with an audience. Here are some of the bigger needs:

~Help getting money donations to afford a back drop and bales of wheat. (We ideally need a total of \$8000, but need a minimun of \$3500). This will require asking local businesses to buy a banner that will be displayed at our outdoor show. Smaller donations will have an small mention on 1 collective banner.

~Organizing the business donations banners, having them printed and setting them up at the show.

~Setting up the pop up stage on the evening before or the morning of the show. This is a slow job and requires laying the Marly flooring on top of the stage.

~Advertising! Making a poster for the show that we can hand out. We will also need help hanging posters around town and posting on social media.

~Make a online program using a QR code. Make a banner with the QR code for audience to use.

~Moving costumes and props to the show.

~Setting up and running the front of house. We will not sell tickets,
