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ACTING CLASSES: All acting students should attend the Tuesday extended 5-6:30 acting class time. PLUS the Wednesday May 22 make up class. Students will need several weeks of practice to ensure the show runs smoothly. Please try and attend all the requested classes.

***Creative Movement, Kindergarten Dance, Pre-Primary, Primary:** All of these classes will join their opposite class in their recital dance. We ask that all students attend 1 class with the other group for their age. For example, Kindergarten Dance Tuesday should attend Kindergarten Dance Thursday and Saturday at least once. More specific details will be handed out in class.

Please arrive 15 minutes early to your Rehearsal.

We try and run as close to “on time” as possible. Being on time for your rehearsal ensures we can dress all the dancers as quickly as possible. Late dancers slow down the process for all the dancers. Please be on time!

Have Hair and Make-Up done as if this was a real show.

In the 12:00 (“B” show) and 5:30 (“D” show) Dress Rehearsals we ***will run the finale first***, then the dancers will go backstage and change into costume. Then, we run the show in order. Dancers may leave after their costume is returned to stock.

Parents MAY NOT go backstage to collect their child. It causes too much confusion and children can get lost. If you wish to be backstage, please sign up to be a much needed volunteer!

Most Important!! This is supposed to be fun and a chance to show off the accomplishments of your child! Don’t stress over the small things, added stress will make the show stressful for you and your child!

“RULES” For a Smooth-Running (Enjoyable!) Show For Adults and Children Alike

Please read and post these rules of the show. If any parent feels that they or their child cannot abide by these rules,
Please do not allow your child to participate in the show.

1. **All Account Must Be Paid By June 1st.**
2. **Dance Design School Must Be Notified In Writing Of All Medical Conditions Before The Show Week.**
3. **Be On Time! 5 or 10 minutes early is even better! Arrive on time for all rehearsals and run-throughs, as they will start (with the children on stage) exactly at the times mentioned.**
4. **No Videotaping or Photography During The Shows. You may videotape the Dress Rehearsals on Thursday and Friday. The studio has an exclusive contract with the videographer and photographers in order to provide a quality record for all, at a reasonable price. Record the Dress Rehearsal if you want a more personal record of your child’s show than the overall professional video is able to produce.**
5. **Absolutely: No Food Or Drink Or Gum Or Cell Phones In The Auditorium Or Backstage. Food and drink get spilled on the costumes and into the surroundings of our host school. Accidents can cause the host school to not allow us to return in future years. We cannot allow this to happen. Children found with food, drink, gum or phones will have it taken from them. Any costumes or host school items damaged due to food or drink will be charged to the parents’ account. A water fountain is available. Any child who can not go 3 1/2 hours (the longest any rehearsal will go) without eating should not participate in the show.**
6. **No Children (Cast Members) In The Audience. We will try to have a video monitor backstage that will allow the cast to see what is happening on stage.**
7. **All Cast MUST Hang Up or Put Away Their Own Costumes After All Shows and Rehearsals. No child will be allowed to return to their parents until his/her costume is put away. NOTE: This usually takes about 20-30 minutes after the show has ended. (Grade 2 and lower will have help) Any costumes lost or damaged because it is not properly put away will be charged to the parents’ account.**
8. **No Parents / Adults Backstage! (Unless they are backstage volunteers) Children are very well supervised backstage. There is very little room backstage.**
9. **Cast Must Check-In and Out 1 Hour Before Each Show. It is impossible to keep track of all the children if parents go backstage and remove them. Please sign your child in and out at every show. This is the only way we are able to keep track of the children and prevent them from wandering off. Dancers on Pointe must arrive an hour and a half early in order to attend the stage warm up. If you are late or miss the warm up you will not be allowed to dance on pointe. *Please remember we have these rules to keep the children safe!**
10. **Permission Slips Must Be At The Check-In Table.**
11. **No Jewelry, Watches, Earrings, Scrunchies, iPods, DS’s, Etc. Please leave them at home.**
12. **Class Attire Must Be Worn To All Rehearsals and Shows (Ladies, no underwear!). Mark All Articles Of Clothing and Shoes With Your Child’s Name.**
13. **Hair Up, In A Bun, For all rehearsals and shows. Do Not Decorate Your Child’s Hair.**
14. **Flowers and Gifts May Not Be Presented On Stage. Please find a private moment to present such gifts to your child.**

***NOTE: Anyone found disobeying the above rules will be asked to leave the show.**
